LogTrade Connect for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central



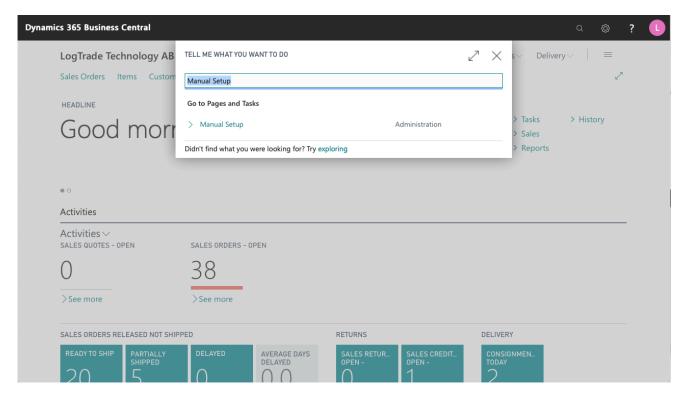


1 GENERAL

This document describes the *Shipping Agent Setup* in LogTrade Connect for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central. After the assisted setup is completed the system is ready for creating transport documents or you can do more advanced setup by either searching for a specific setup or using *Manual Setup*. This means that before going through this document you should have run *Assisted Setup* for *LogTrade Connect*.

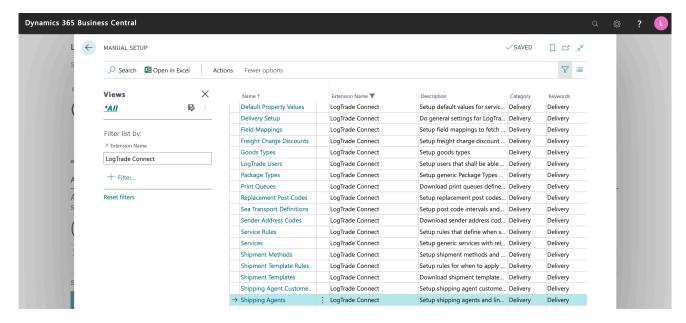
2 MANUAL SETUP

Open *Manual Setup* by searching with the search functionality.





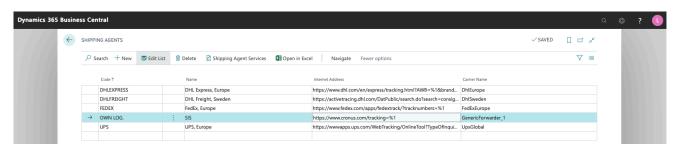
You can filter on "Extension Name" = "LogTrade Connect" to see all setup related to LogTrade Connect.



Scroll down to and click on Shipping Agents to open the list of all shipping agents.

3 SHIPPING AGENTS

In the page *Shipping Agents*, you define a relation between *Shipping Agent Code* and *Carrier Name*. Carrier Name is a code in LogTrade for each carrier. This means that warehouse employees work with the ordinary Shipping Agents and Shipping Agent Services while LogTrade get the correct codes for each carrier and carrier product. The *Carrier Names* are downloaded from LogTrade automatically when running *Assisted Setup* and if any carriers are added after the initial setup a refresh can be done from the page *Carriers* before mapping Shipping Agents.



FIELD NAME	DESCRIPTION
CODE	The Shipping Agent Code in Dynamics 365 Business Central.
NAME	The name for the Shipping Agent. This will be updated automatically when <i>Carrier Name</i> is filled in.



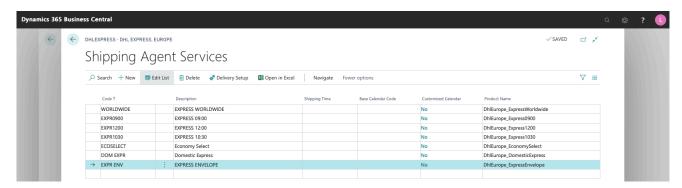


INTERNET ADDRESS	Standard field in Dynamics 365 Business Central, used for package tracking.
CARRIER NAME	The carrier name in LogTrade. This field will update <i>Name</i> automatically when with the carrier name.

3.1 SHIPPING AGENT SERVICES

The Shipping Agent Services are opened with the button Shipping Agent Services on the Shipping Agent page. A Shipping Agent Service is equal to what is also called Carrier Product like for example DB Schenker-System, DHL Express-Express Worldwide, DHL Freight-Parcel, DSV Road-e-Parcel, FedEx-International Economy, PostNord-MyPack Collect and UPS-Express Saver.

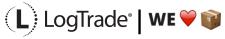
The *Product Names* are downloaded from LogTrade automatically when running *Assisted Setup* and if any Carrier Product are added after the initial setup a refresh can be done from the page *Carriers* before mapping Shipping Agents Services.

CODE	The Shipping Agent Service Code in Dynamics 365 Business Central.
DESCRIPTION	The description for the Shipping Agent Service. This will be updated automatically when <i>Product Name</i> is filled in.
SHIPPING TIME	Standard field in Dynamics 365 Business Central.
BASE CALENDAR CODE	Standard field in Dynamics 365 Business Central.
CUSTOMIZED CALENDAR	Standard field in Dynamics 365 Business Central.
PRODUCT NAME	The product name in LogTrade. This field will update <i>Description</i> automatically when with the product description.

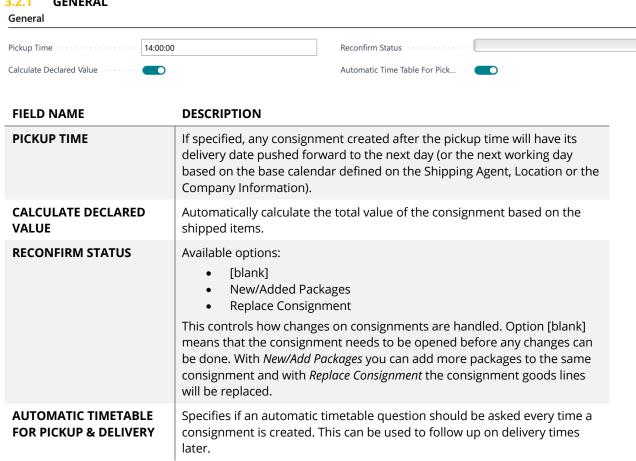
3.2 SHIPPING AGENT SERVICE DELIVERY SETUP

For each *Shipping Agent Service*, it is possible to do a lot of customized settings on how to handle pickup times, default goods lines and freight costs. This is to make the process in Dynamics 365 Business Central as automatic as possible.

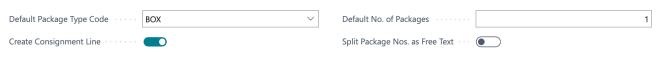

DEFAULT PACKAGE The default Package Type Code to use on consignment lines. **CREATE CONSIGNMENT** If enabled, a consignment line will be automatically created when using the LINE product. **DEFAULT NO. OF** The number of packages to use for an automatically inserted consignment





SPLIT PACKAGES NOS. AS FREE TEXT

If enabled, the package/tracking numbers from connected split consignments will be inserted as free text on the consignment containing the "split children".

3.2.3 TRACKING

This fast tab specifies how to handle

3.2.4 FREIGHT COST

On this fast tab you specify how you want to automate cost calculation. Both for statistics purposes and for invoicing to recipient.

FIELD NAME	DESCRIPTION
AUTOMATIC CALCULATION	Defines if an automatic freight calculation should be done and presented on the consignment.
CHARGE FREIGHT COST	Defines if the calculated freight cost should be charged to the recipient.
LINE TYPE	Available options:



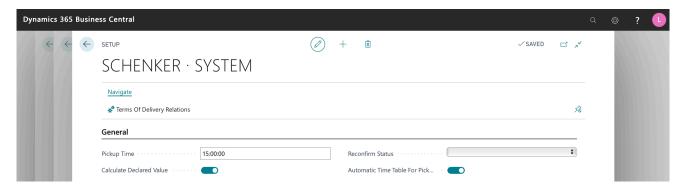


	 [blank] G/L Account Item Charge (Item) The line type that shall be used when a freight line is charged on the source document. If using Inventory Pick or Warehouse documents, it is recommended to use items to make the posting process better.
NO.	The number to use on the freight line on the source document, dependent on the <i>Line Type</i> .
ITEM CHARGE DISTRIBUTION	Available options: • [blank] • Equally • Amount If Line Type is <i>Charge (Item)</i> this setting will define how the charge amount shall be distributed on the source document lines.
SUPPLEMENTARY CHARGE %	With this setting it is possible to increase the cost inserted on the source document to add an additional profit margin before invoicing the recipient.

3.2.5 TERMS OF DELIVERY RELATIONS

For each *Shipping Agent Service* that are used for international shipments it is normally important to specify *Terms of Delivery Relations*. Each Shipping Agent might have different allowable *Shipment Methods* (called Terms of Delivery in LogTrade) and therefore it is important to map a Dynamics 365 Business Central *Shipment Method* with corresponding LogTrade *Terms of Delivery*. Read more in documentation about *Terms of Deliveries*.

Terms of Delivery Relations are found on the Navigate menu.

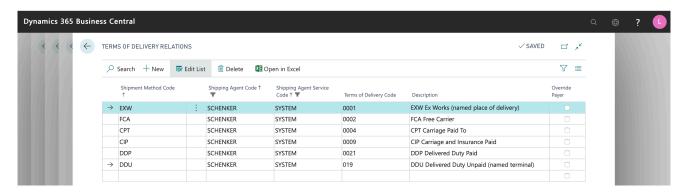


During the *Assisted Setup* all available *Terms of Deliveries* have been downloaded and a suggested mapping can have been done based on that the *Shipment Method Code* in Dynamics 365 Business Central is found as a *Terms of Delivery Code* from LogTrade.





The purpose of this relations mapping is that the user at the warehouse doesn't need to be concerned about the specific code for each carrier, just as for example *Package Types* work.

SHIPPING AGENT SERVICE CODE Shipping Agent Service Code from Dynamics 365 Business Central.

TERMS OF DELIVERY CODE Available Terms of Deliveries from LogTrade for selected Shipping Agent Service.

DESCRIPTION The description for selected Terms of Delivery Code from LogTrade.
